What:

Summer Semester is for students who want to get a jump on high school or free up their class schedule for more electives. The cost is \$70 per half-credit class.

Where and When:

All classes are delivered Monday through Thursday over three weeks in a blended-learning format: from June 10-20 courses are delivered face-to-face at Mount Jordan Middle, 9351 S. Mountaineer Lane in Sandy; and from June 24-27, courses are delivered online.

Important Information

How do I register?

Registration will take place April 15th thru May 24th, 2019. Registration will be first-come, first-served, as classes fill up quickly. Registration and payment for all courses will be submitted through <http://canyons.revtrak.net>.

Refunds

Refunds for course fees must be requested by **3:00 pm Friday, May 24th 2019**. Students requiring a fee waiver, or who may qualify for certain accommodations through the McKinney-Vento Homeless Assistance Act, will be assisted. We also will provide extra assistance to English Language Learners, refugees, migrants, etc.

What is the format for the 2019 summer semester?

A blended-learning format will be utilized for all summer semester courses. Blending refers to a mix of face-to-face and online learning. For the weeks of June 10th and June 17th, students will be required to attend courses at the location listed on the reverse side of this flyer. For the week of June 24th students will complete the course on-Line. Approximately 40 percent of the course content will be delivered online. All online course work must be completed by Thursday, June 27th.

***Students in Financial Literacy will need to take a face to face proctored state exam at Mt. Jordan MS on Thursday, June 27th, or have an opt-out form signed by their parent/Legal Guardian.**

Where will classes be held?

Classes will take place at Mount Jordan Middle School, 9351 S. Mountaineer Lane, Sandy, Utah, 84070.

What is the attendance policy?

Due to the condensed scheduling of the summer semester, a strict attendance/tardy policy is mandatory. Students are allowed up to one absence and two tardies per course. **If the attendance/tardy policy is violated, students will not receive a passing grade for the course, regardless of the reason.** Please note: there will NOT be school on Fridays.

Student Discipline Policy

Summer sessions are very short and the opportunity to take summer semester courses is a privilege therefore student behavior problems and disruptions will not be tolerated in the classroom or on the school campus. Student who participate in disruption maybe expelled from the summer semester.

Who can take summer school courses?

Students enrolling in 9th-12th grades for the 2019-2020 school year may take summer semester courses. Out-of-district students are welcome to apply.
