If you have any questions or do not have computer access available, walk-in online registration is still available on the following dates:

Sophomores:	Wednesday, August 15 th	(8:00 AM to 12:00 PM)
Freshmen:	Thursday, August 16 th	(8:00 AM to 12:00 PM)

Pictures will be taken during the above walk-in registration dates. **Even if you complete the registration process online, you should plan on coming to the school during walk-in registration to get your picture taken for the yearbook and your school I.D.** Please see the enclosed flyer for additional information. (SCHOOL DRESS CODE APPLIES FOR SCHOOL PICTURES)

Payment for registration fees can be made online with a credit card. However, if you would like to pay with cash or check, you may pay in our main office (Monday thru Friday, 7:00 AM to 1:30 PM) after August 2nd.

Fees for Athletic Participation will be paid separately in the main office or online through Registermyathlete.com.

Class fees for specific courses will not be accepted until after school begins.

Fee Waivers: If you qualify or believe you may qualify for a fee waiver, you will need to meet with your assistant principal after August 2nd to complete that process in order to finalize your registration. Once your fee waiver has been approved, you will be able to view your schedule. Your assistant principal is assigned by the first letter of the student's last name.

Lockers: Locker assignments and combinations will be found on Skyward for sophomores, juniors, and seniors. Freshman will be required to share a locker. Freshmen will be able to select their lockers beginning Thursday, August 16th during walk-in registration. Freshmen will also be able to make locker arrangements during Freshmen Orientation. **It is strongly advised that no items of great value be brought to school.**

Portraits: See enclosed flyer for additional information. Separate payment to the photographer must be made for school pictures. Students must be dressed according to the dress code in order to have portraits taken. Checks should be written to Lifetouch Photography.

Schedule Changes: Arena scheduling will be open from August 6th thru August 16th to allow students to go in and make their own schedule adjustments. Counselors will be available to assist with arena scheduling on a first-come, first-served basis on Wednesday, August 15th from 8:00 AM to 2:00 PM and Thursday, August 16th from 8:00 AM to 11:00 AM. After arena scheduling closes on August 16th, students' schedules should be final.

Parking Permits: Because of construction and limited parking spaces, information about parking permits will be sent at a later date.

Insurance: Brighton High School ***does not*** insure students against accidents or other injuries incurred at school or school-sponsored activities in or outside the school day or elsewhere during school hours. Students participating in athletics or other extra-curricular activities are not automatically covered against accidents and other injuries. ***Athletes must be covered by their own insurance. Personal property is not covered by school insurance. We highly recommend that personal items of value be left at home.***

School Lunch: Brighton High School operates a daily school breakfast and lunch program. The cost of a school breakfast for students will be \$1.10; lunch will be \$2.00. We encourage all students to take advantage of the nutritious lunches which are prepared for them daily.

Student numbers are used as lunch numbers. Lunch deposits will be accepted at registration or in the cafeteria beginning the first day of school. Throughout the year, deposits must be in before 9:45 a.m. to be credited for that day. Each student must always use the number issued to him/her even when paying cash at the register. **We do not give IOUs or let students carry a debit balance at the high school level.**

We do participate in the free or reduced price lunch program, and we encourage families to apply if they feel they are eligible. Please return the completed form to your assistant principal or in the cafeteria. Forms may be found online at www.canyonsdistrict.org or in the main office.
